Mr. Neil Kaplan, CBE, QC, SBS has over 40 years' experience in dispute resolution, including a practice at the London Bar, as a government lawyer and practice as a Queen's Counsel in Hong Kong. From 1990 to 1994 he was a judge of the Hong Kong High Court where he was in charge of the Construction and Arbitration List.

Since 1995, Mr. Kaplan has solely performed the role of international arbitrator and has held several hundred cases as co-arbitrator, sole arbitrator or chairman of an arbitral tribunal. He has conducted a wide range of commercial, infrastructural and investment treaty disputes under the rules of ICC, HKIAC, LCIA, UNCITRAL, SIAC, SCC, ICSID and CIETAC. He held various positions such as Chairman of the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre, Chairman of the WTO Review Panel for Hong Kong as well as President of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. In addition to being a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, he is also a Fellow of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators and a Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators, as well as a panelist at many arbitration centres including CIETAC and a member of the LCIA.

At the Interactive Seminar, Mr. Kaplan will discuss questions concerning international arbitration.
